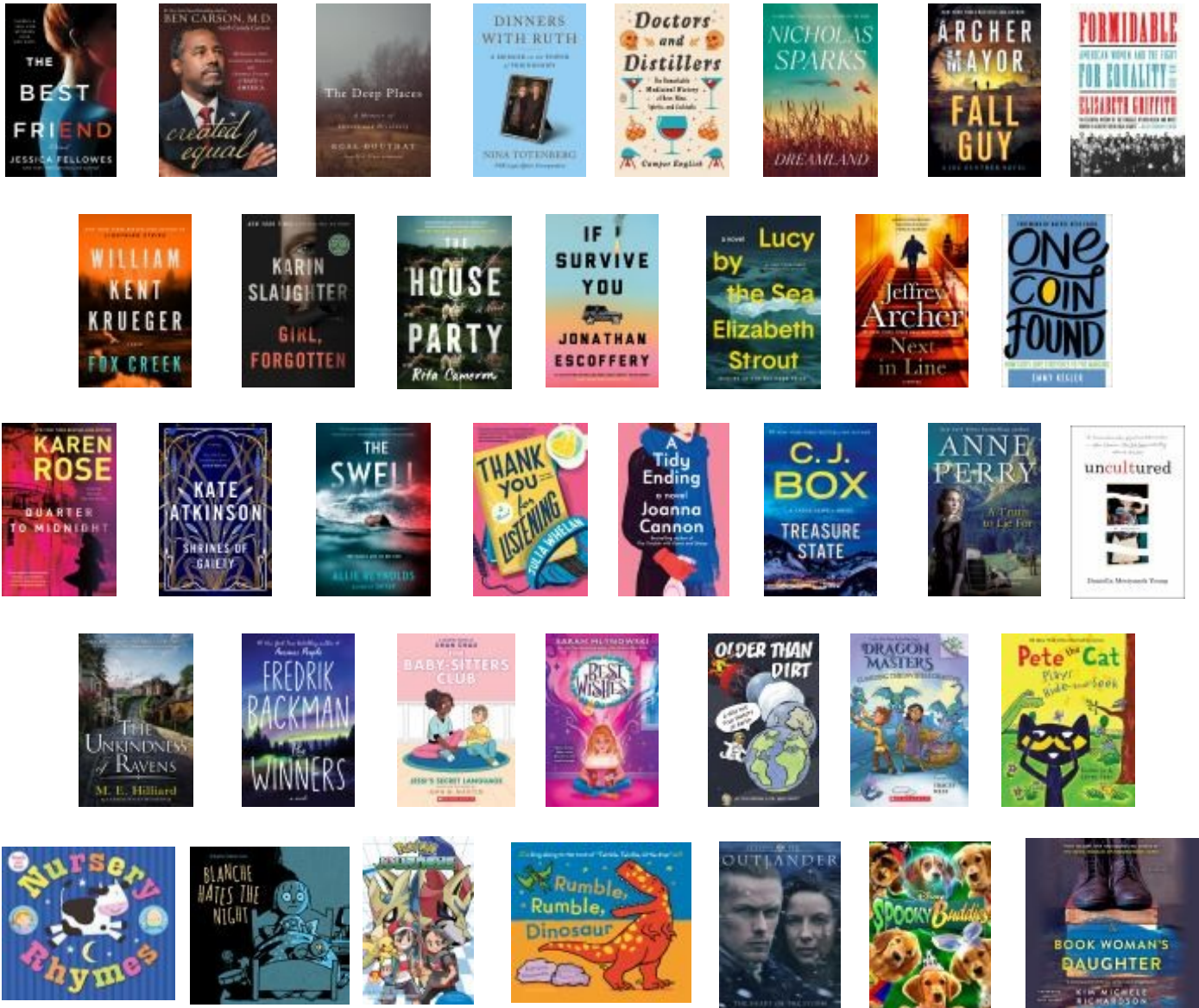
New Items!
