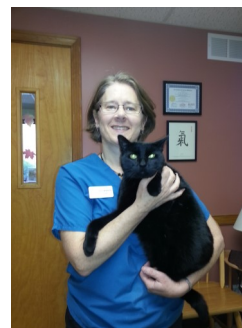

Pet Dental Disease Wednesday, February 22 7 p.m.

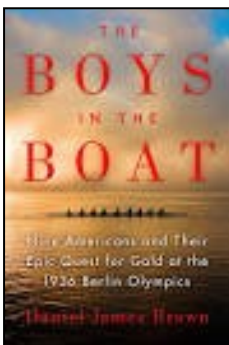
Dr. Karen Woodberry of Oyster River Veterinary Hospital will be speaking about Pet Dental Hygiene.

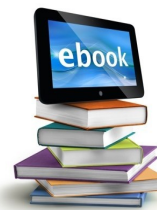

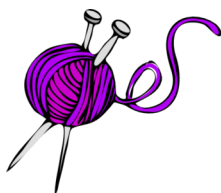

Fridays January 20-February 24

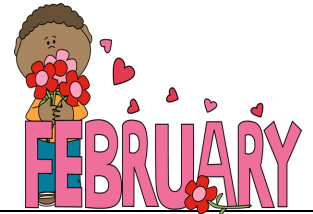
3:30-4:30 p.m.

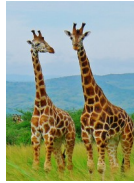

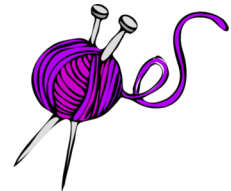

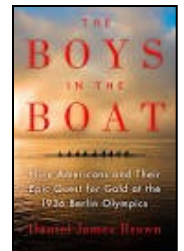
