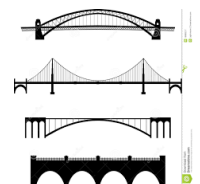


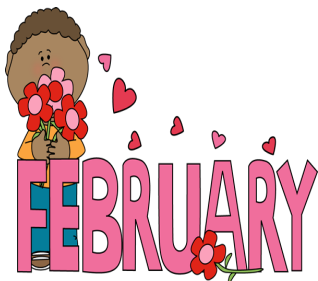
STEM Program - Truss-ted Bridge Design

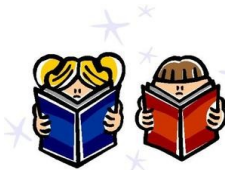

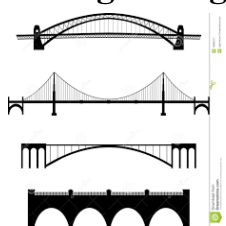
