We would like to say a huge thank you to **Annalee Mack** for allowing us to display her wonderful works for the past few months, these beautiful pieces have been a joy to see in our library!

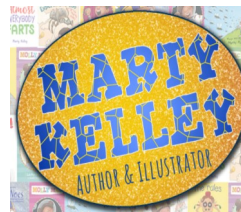

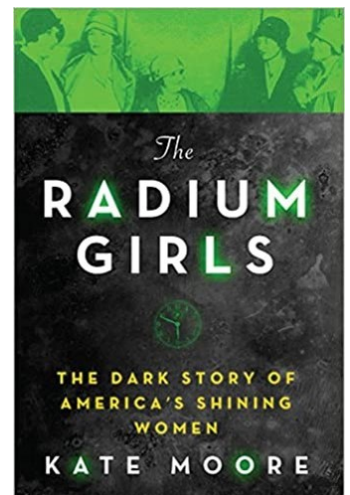
