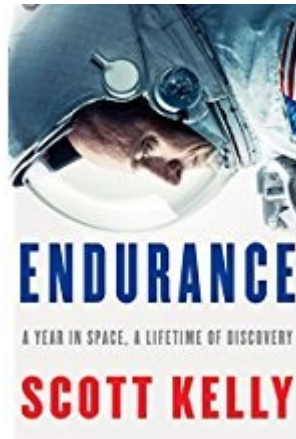
#### Endurance

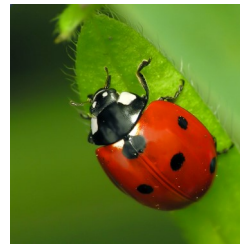

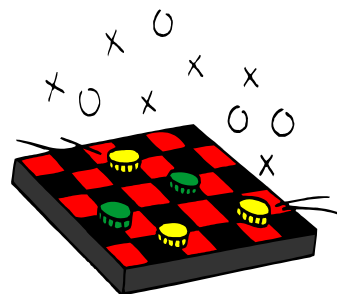

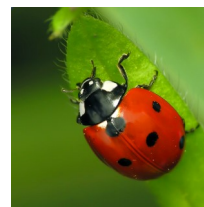
