More recently, she has been learning to weave, once again experimenting with non-traditional techniques, several examples of which are included in this exhibit. For children up to 2 years of age, this 20 minute program offers songs, stories and movement with relaxed time afterwards for play and socializing.

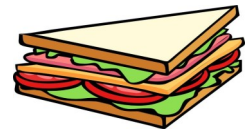
## Story Time –Fridays—10:30-11:30
