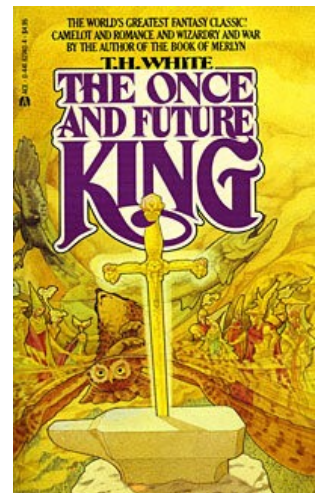

Curbside Pickup is A Breeze

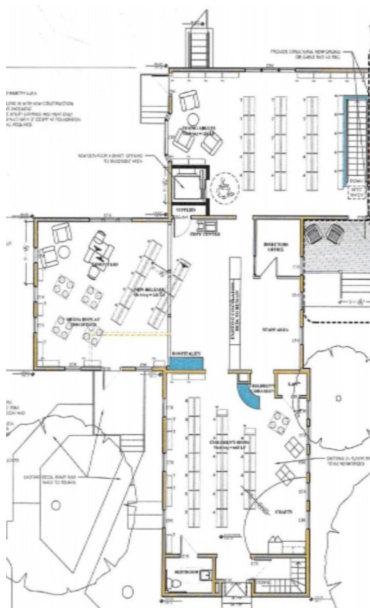

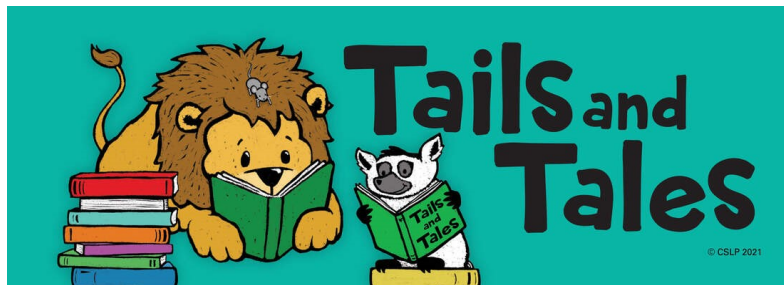
