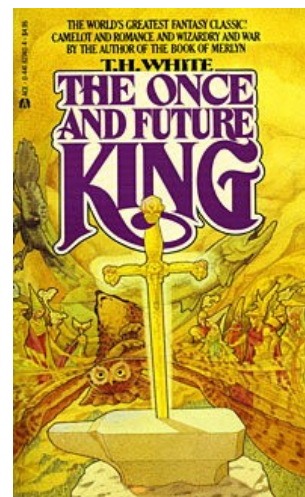

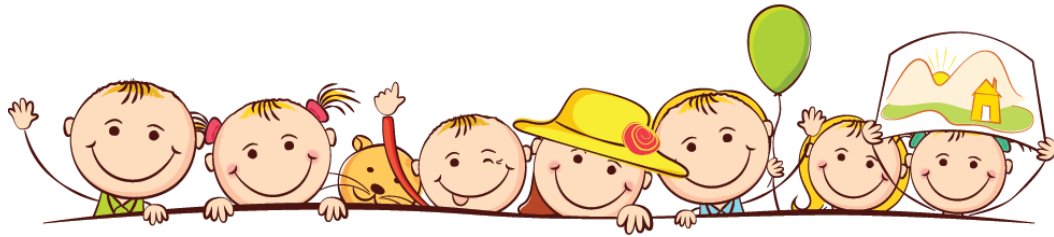

Pajama Story time - Wednesday, September 29

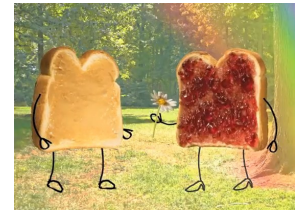

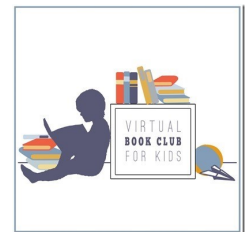
