Summer Campers Policy

People who are camping for the season at one of Lee's campgrounds (Ferndale Acres, Forest Glen, Wadleigh Falls, and Wellington Campground) **are not** considered to have resident status in the Town of Lee. Per the Town of Lee Selectmen's interpretation of the New Hampshire residency laws (RSA 21.6), campgrounds are not classified as year-round residential facilities. Therefore a camper may not claim his/her campsite as his/her principal place of abode in order to declare residency status. A Post Office box featuring a Durham/Lee zip code is not sufficient to claim residency.

1. Campers may obtain a library card for the *reduced* annual non-resident rate of \$15.00
2. Campers applying for a non-resident card must provide their off-season mailing address and telephone number.

After payment of their non-resident fee, summer campers will be allocated six consecutive months, beginning on the date of payment, to use Library services.
